

SELF-SERVICE PATIENT ACCESS TO YOUR DATA THAT RESIDES ON ROCHESTER RHIO

Per Federal law, patients have a right to a copy of their data from any provider or HIPAA-covered entity based on the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, including Rochester RHIO. Furthermore, patients are entitled to their medical records data “in a form convenient for patients, in a reasonable manner” per the 21st Century Cures Act.

We provide a simple way for patients to download a copy of all their data in Rochester RHIO. [With luck, every one of the patient’s providers and facilities already participates with Rochester RHIO, and the patient will get a full and complete medical record going back at least 5 years. However, it is possible that some local providers are not participants in Rochester RHIO, and / or will not share all data they collect and produce about the patient with Rochester RHIO.]

To request their data using the QR code, any adult patient with a valid ID can use a smart phone to quickly create an account, get their identity verified, and obtain a copy of their medical records from Rochester RHIO, all for free. Also, the patient may get their data from previous treatments at additional locations in the country, if those facilities or HIEs participate in this or other nationwide networks.




*Please note, minors and patients without a valid ID must contact their providers directly to obtain their records.

Patients also have the option to use their own personal health application (PHA), if it has applied and been accepted as an authorized patient application by the Selfii system. SELFII USER GUIDE


1. Users: Utilize the QR code to navigate to get started. You will be asked to login with a common authenticator, ie. Google or Apple, or to create your own account with an email.

*Note: no password is required for one-time code login process.




2. Following your login/account creation, users are asked to consent for Selfii to search for their data on their behalf.
3. Complete your profile and the account creation step by entering the information as requested.



- Once this process is complete, click the “Search For My Data” button in the top right corner to begin verifying your identity.
- CLEAR, also known as [Clear Secure, Inc.](#), will request your basic information, like mobile number and email address.



6. After collecting your information, you will then be asked to take a selfie.

*Remove any glasses and hats.

7. Finally, you will be asked to scan your government issued ID to complete your identity verification.




9. Once you click ‘Send’, you will automatically be redirected to Selfii.com.



10. The service will search for your records, 'search is in progress' displays.
11. When records are found, they will be available as both human and machine-readable versions.

Given her complex medical condition and extensive medication regimen, Tania requires careful monitoring and regular follow-ups to manage her breast cancer treatment, potential side effects, and overall health.
